Scattergood Friends School receives funds

The Scattergood Friends School in West Branch has received \$2,000 through the Iowa Farm Bureau Federation (IFBF) Challenge Grant program. The funds will be used to give students ag education opportunities throughout the year.

The students will learn about rotational grazing, different breeds of cattle and how to raise livestock by working cooperatively on a neighboring farm. In return, the farm will supply the school with fresh beef and lamb and ag education.

Craig Lang. "The organization works to fulfill this mission by providing financial assistance to community-based projects across the state."
